41. On **22nd December 2019** team Bansdroni Hridhi arrived in the small village of Chandipur, in South 24 parganas. This village is extremely under developed with most of its inhabitants living below the poverty line. Most of the villagers don't have basic necessities like clothing and proper shelter. Thus we distributed **Blankets (50 Nos.)**, **Tarpaulin Sheets (25 Nos.)**, **Woollen clothes (60 Nos.)** and cots (2 Nos.) to many.











We also gave out old reusable clothes and blankets to some underprivileged villagers.



A free medical and dental health camp was conducted where approximately 100 patients were examined and free medicines were distributed. We wish to continue working in this village and make a small effort in its upliftment.











42. On 9th February 2020 we again visited in that small village of Chandipur, in South 24 Parganas. We distributed Exercise Books, Pen, pencil, eraser and sharpener among 100 poor students, so that they can continue their education. We distributed new Blankets among 18 needy villagers. We also distributed old but usable clothes among the underprivileged villagers, We conducted again a health camp there and distributed medicine at free of cost amongst 60 villagers. Along with Medical camp we arranged a counselling session among 42-50 villagers on General Health and Hygiene.













43. Our world is going through unforeseen circumstances. The COVID -19 pandemic has brought everything to a standstill and there has been a lockdown globally since weeks now to arrest the spread of this virulent virus. India too has been under lockdown since 25<sup>th</sup> March 2020. Though this is a mandatory step in trying to keep this disease in check, our country being a developing one with many people living below the poverty line, is facing extreme difficulties. Though our government has been providing food to the poor, there are many who are going hungry. Under these circumstances, Bansdroni Hridhi has taken the initiative to provide food to some homeless people. From 28th March to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020, we have provided lunch to 110 pavement dwellers in Jadavpur station, Baghajatin and Ramgarh area.

44. On **28**<sup>th</sup> **March 2020** we has also distributed breakfast to **30 people** in a Govt. night shelter for street dwellers run by 'Mitali Mohila Sangho' at Viveknagar near Jadavpur station for 5 days.
