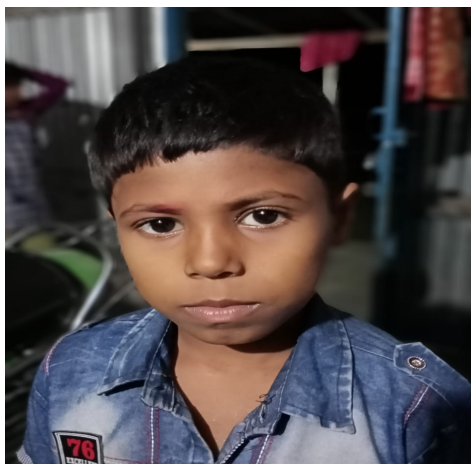




117. On 12<sup>th</sup> June 2022, lunch has been distributed among the 50 orphan children of 'Soujatya' orphanage at Dhakuria.

# *OUR FUTURE PLANS*



### **Nutritional Support:**

We have already started to provide nutritional support to 3 (three) orphans immunocompromised children from April 2019 and latter on the number raised upto eight. We have also provided nutritional support to 3 elderly underprivileged people. We want to increase the no. of both children and elderly people.

### **Awareness Campaign:**

We want to continue our awareness program throughout the year on various issues like: “save water”, “global warming”, “and bad side of use of plastics”, “necessity of plantation”, “Body/Organ donation” etc.

### **Uncared child and differently abled child:**

We want to extend our hand towards the uncared child and differently abled child, to make their life meaningful

### **Campaign against Cervical Cancer, RTI, HIV/AIDS, Thalassemia & other diseases and on Blood Donation**

We want to continue our campaign against cervical cancer and RTI (Reproductive Tract Infection) with the awareness to use sanitary napkins among the underprivileged adolescent girls and women of rural areas. We also want to continue our campaign on Thalassemia & other communicable and non-communicable disease. And continuation of blood donation camp to meet up the crisis of blood and make people aware about the effectiveness of blood donation is one of our aim.

### **Mobile Cloth bank:**

Encouraged by the stupendous success of our project of distributing old clothes in various rural areas, we have now decided to purchase a vehicle which will function as a “Mobile Clothes Bank” for collecting old clothes from Kolkata and surrounding areas and distributing them to the underprivileged in the rural areas of West Bengal.

### **Ambulance Service:**

Though this is a well-known service and readily available, our dream is to provide one for rural areas. We aim to provide this facility free of cost, to the underprivileged people in rural areas in an around Kolkata. Funds for acquiring an ambulance and maintaining the same will be funded by our members, friends, associates and kind donors.

## OLDPHANAGE - OUR DREAM:



Bansdroni Hridhi's long term dream is to build an "Oldphanage" – an old age home and an orphanage in two separate houses within the same premises. This is one of the best ideas to implement as it would avoid overcrowding and ensure individual attention for both groups of people.

Children need a lot of activity in their life, which the elderly would not be able to cope up with. The elderly would tend to have a medical focus, making them comfortable in their last days of life. Their daily activities would have to be different.

It would have so many benefits for all the persons involved.

Senior citizens need someone to talk to, besides fellow residents, and the orphans can benefit from meeting adults who aren't their caretakers, on a regular basis. The young people could learn from the wisdom of the elderly, and the elderly might be cheered by a group of lively children.



The elderly would feel attached with the small children. They would find comfort and love in their presence. They can spend their last days with the kids as if they are spending good time with their grandchildren. This is one of the best possible ways to lessen their pain because many of the old people (are very much obsessed with their families and crave for their love and come back.

They could easily pass their time by engaging themselves in teaching those kids, helping them in doing homework, packing their lunch boxes in the morning, plaiting the kids, playing with them rather than chit-chatting with the fellow mates. They would get someone who really assists them for a walk; the one who accompanies them for a medical check-up.

The children will also be loved by the elderly. They will gain the love and care of a family which otherwise they would not get. They will get good company to share things that happened in their school or their day to day life. They will get good grandparents from whom they can hear stories, values and morals especially the ones who can really assist them with their studies. Children would need to be sensitized about being around old people. Usually our parents teach us how to care about our grandparents, but we would have to do that for orphans. Generally, children in an orphanage are wiser for their age and more caring and empathetic.

Hridhi has already purchased a land at Baruipur Sub Division of South 24 Parganas district of West Bengal for **OLADPHANAGE**, requesting you to contribution so that orphan children and uncared elderly people get food and don't sleep hungry.
